- Must have completed a minimum of 60 credit hours towards a BA/BS from an accredited college/university prior to or by conclusion of this 9-week program to apply
- Must be entering your junior or senior year of college and be in good academic and financial standing with the college/university
- Experience with MS Office skills
- Students in the following degree programs will be given preference but not limited:
 - International Studies
 - Logistics/Sustainment
 - Business
 - Financial
- Self-starter with the willingness to take initiative and create solutions
- Process improvement focus with the ability to see and suggest appropriate changes
- Ability to communicate positively and effectively with peers, corporate representatives, and government officials
- Ability to work 40 hours/week, Monday - Friday
